

Another theme that emerged from our research relates to what students learned about themselves as a result of taking part in religious, cultural or social justice type clubs. The type of learning ranges greatly. Some students mentioned to us that they had learned a lot about time management and becoming more focused and organized because they so enjoyed their club involvement that they realized they needed to find ways to make time for these extracurricular activities.

On the other hand, we saw that many of the students learned a lot about their own, perhaps, prejudices and limitations when they were spending more time with others who were different from them.
