Confused about what can be linked directly in Blackboard? Start here!

Do-It-Yourself Linking

I want to link to....	Start at www.library.utoronto.ca , then click on...
A specific journal article owned by the Library	Article Finder → [search for item] → [get it! UTL] → [Save a link to this article] → [get the link]
A journal or book in the library catalogue	Catalogue → [title] → View Details (eye icon) → Permanent link
A specific library database/index that my students should use	E-resources → [title] → Read More → Need a permanent link to this resource?
All library databases/indexes for a particular subject	Search for Articles → Option 1 → [select topic] → [copy URL]
The library catalogue search	http://discover.library.utoronto.ca/catalogue
A library research guide	Quick Links → Research Guides → [select topic] → [copy guide URL]
 My course reading list in RefWorks to share with my students	Quick Links → RefWorks → [login] → Folders → Share Folders → [copy URL of shared folder]
Learning objects and images that I could use in my course	Faculty → Blackboard Help → More Services for Instructors → Library's list of learning object repositories & referatories

Google Scholar

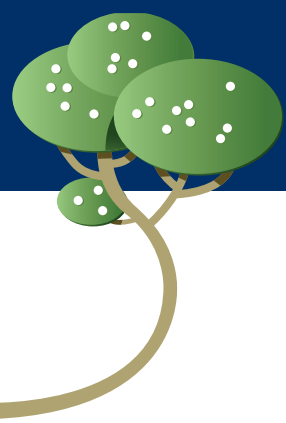
I want to link to....	Start at scholar.google.ca , then click on...
A journal article in Google Scholar	Scholar Preferences → Library Links → [enter Toronto] → select Get It! University of Toronto → Save Preferences
Add a link from a Google Scholar article to RefWorks	Scholar Preferences → Bibliography Manager → [select Show links to import citations into RefWorks] (If prompted, U of T RefWorks group code is RWToronto) → [topic or title] → [Import into RefWorks]

Course Reserve Readings

I want to link to....	Start at www.library.utoronto.ca , then click on...
Ask the library to add links to my required reading list	Faculty → Supporting Teaching → Put Items on Course Reserve → How to submit your reading list to the library

Blackboard Library Resources Pages

I want to link to....	Start at portal.utoronto.ca , then click on...
See the Library Resources page in my Blackboard course	[select course] → Library Resources
Change the content of a Library Resources page	[select course] → Library Resources → Liaison Librarian
