I'm Colin MacNeil. I'm Vice Principal here at Sir Oliver Mowat in Scarborough. I've been at the school for about 5 years and work closely with teachers and with the clubs right at the school. We have a regular super council meeting every month in which we meet with various clubs. And they kind of report to us as an administration on what they are up to and what they're about and specifically the Sassy group, the Me to We group, the Christian Club and some of the clubs that have a more social justice slant, certainly that I've been involved with since I've been here....It's really supporting the teachers that are working directly with the groups. We like to provide that link between the administration and the kids with our monthly super council meeting. But it's providing support for the teachers. And we do make visits to some of the meetings that happen and just let the kids know that the administration supports what they're doing and what their efforts are. But, these kids, they're such high flyers, great kids. They always keep us in the loop as to what's going on and most everything that they want to do gets green lighted. You know you have to hold on to the reigns sometimes because they want to kind of lead the way.
